What we have learned over time:

- Child's Name has a hard time paying attention to only one thing at a time (ADHD -Inattentive Type)
- Child's Name has a hard time with phonological awareness, phonological memory, and rapid naming (Dyslexia)
- Child's Name has a hard time organizing his thoughts and getting them down onto paper (Dysgraphia)
- Child's Name will quietly cry, turn away, have tics, and get nervous (Anxiety)
- Child's Name routinely forgets and loses his things, has difficulties planning, and can not organize himself (Executive Functioning Difficulties)
- Child's Name does not take medication and has seasonal allergies.
